

Q23WZ Work, Health and Safety Policy

- Relevant policies, procedures, information, instruction, training, and supervision are adequately provided to employees.

Ampac Pty Ltd. Management recognises the important contribution employees play regarding the effective management of safety and health. All Ampac Pty Ltd. employees are actively encouraged to participate in consultation with management on issues that may affect their health and safety directly or through Health and Safety Representatives and the Safety Committees.

For contract works, to be performed successfully at Ampac Pty Ltd., all contractors are required to read, sign and comply with Ampac Pty Ltd.'s Safety requirements for contractors.

The nominated officer pursuant to the applicable legislation is the Managing Director.

The nominated officer is responsible and accountable for the development, implementation, and review of management systems and the allocation of reasonable resources to ensure the objectives of Ampac Pty Ltd.'s Work, Health and Safety Policy are met.
